


How to access Zoom (Student Directions)


1. Open Schoology

- Double-click on the Schoology icon on the student laptop or...
- Open Chrome, then go to www.fcps.edu and click on Schoology from the menu at the top

2. Sign in using your FCPS username and password, then click Sign In.





3. Click on *Courses* and locate your *Homeroom Course*.



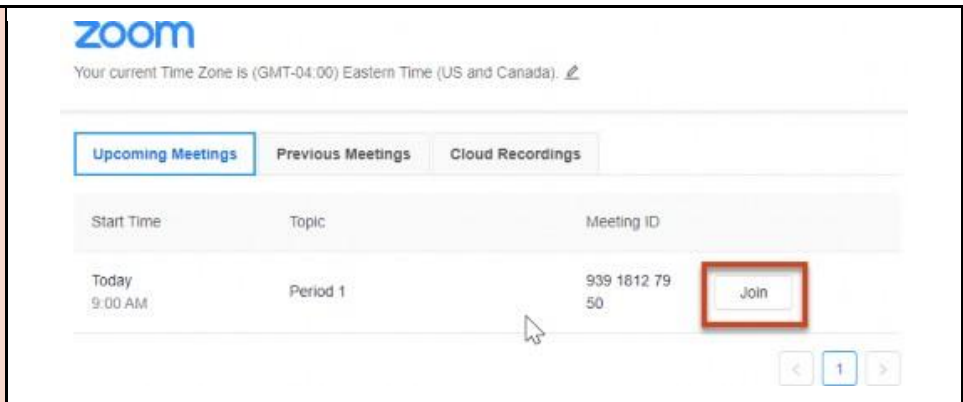

4. Go to Zoom.

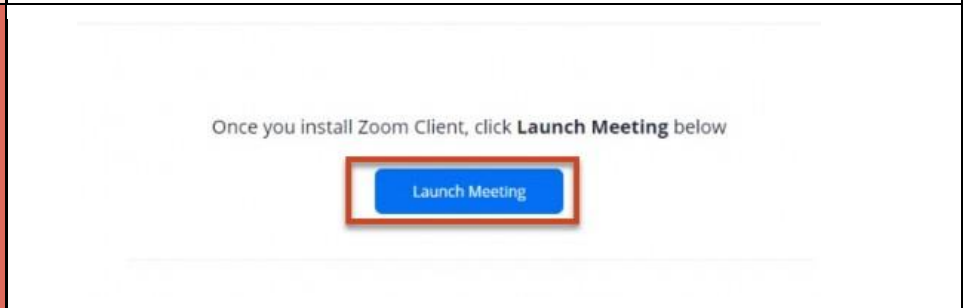

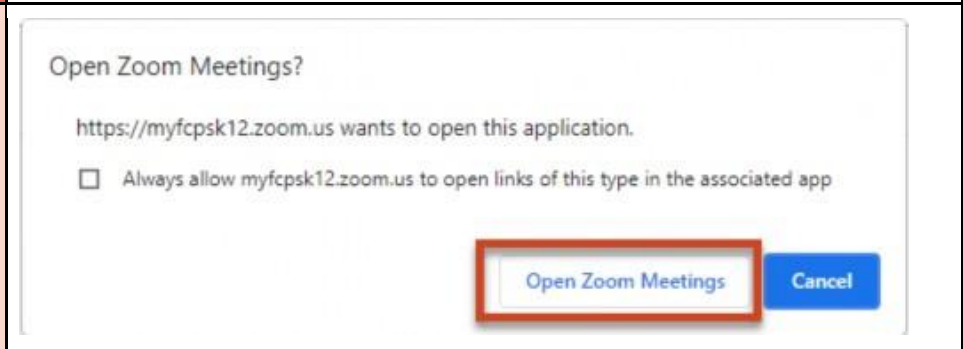
5. Join Zoom session.



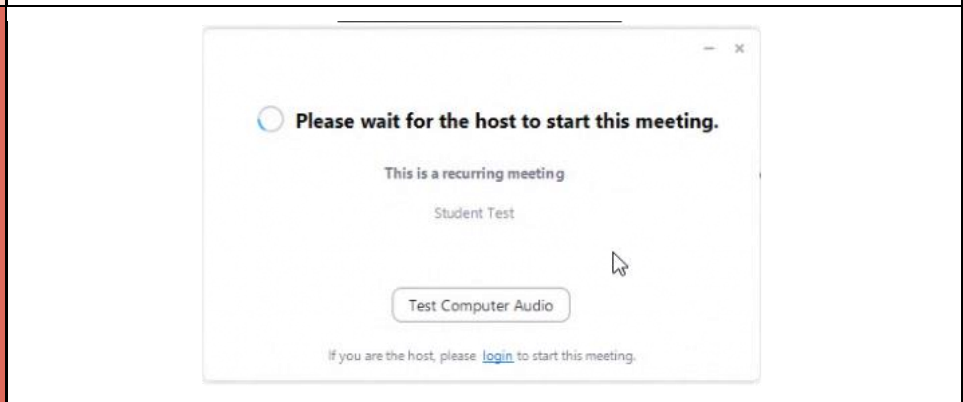
6. Click Launch Meeting
